ICE Enforcement in the OC: WHAT YOU CAN DO TO HELP

- Document (photos or video preferred) any possible ICE actions that you see and report them to the OC Rapid Response Network hotline at 714-881-1558 using SALUTE: Size, Activity, Location, Uniform, Time/date, Equipment
- Volunteer to do court accompaniment
- Join a grocery group to buy and/or deliver needed supplies to those afraid to leave their homes
- Adopt a car wash or day laborer site and get to know the people who work there
- Buy out fruit and flower vendors so they can go home and be safe for the day
- Hand out red KYR cards to people and/or establishments that might be vulnerable
- Donate to the OC Rapid Response Network* to help families with pressing needs and to the OC
 Justice Fund to help bond people out of immigration detention
- Talk to your family and friends about what's really happening to our immigrant neighbors
